

Before using the battery, read these instructions and precautions. Failure to follow this manual could result in a dangerous situations or disruption of the battery.

Safety instructions

- Do not disassemble or short-circuit the battery
- Do not recharge the battery.
- Keep the battery away from sources of heat and fire.
- Do not allow metal objects to contact the battery terminals.
- Do not mix with used or other battery type.
- Do not solder the batteries directly.
- Do not over-discharge batteries.
- Do not install the battery in harsh environments such as damp, greasy, flammable, explosive or dust accumulation.
- Use batteries in controlled conditions.
- Don't crush, puncture, take apart batteries or otherwise damage batteries.
- Remove batteries from device when it is not in use.
- Keep away from animals and children

Exploitation

Do not keep batteries at temperature of 85°C or above. Batteries can operate from temperatures -55°C, however their performance will be significantly low.

Emergency situations

Old or damaged alkaline batteries can leak. When leakage is noticed, put the battery in a safe place. If substances come into contact with the skin, immediately flush with plenty of clean water.

In the event of overheat:




- Remove the battery carefully
- Place it in a non-flammable container
- Allow it to cool down naturally

In the event of fire:

- Alert those in the danger zone
- Move away from the fire area
- Call the fire department
- If it is possible ventilate the room and cool the battery
- Use a class A/B/C/D fire extinguisher or sand to extinguish the fire.

Recycling

Used batteries should be handed over to the appropriate collection and recycling facilities.

Symbols on the battery	
	Do not charge.
	Do not mix used and new batteries.
	Do not mix different brands or types of batteries.
	Check for correct polarity (+/-).
	Do not swallow.
	Battery can explode or leak if shorted.
	Do not damage.
	Do not dispose in fire.
	Do not disassemble.
	Keep away from children.
	The product conforms with health, safety, and environmental protection standards for products sold within the EEA.
	The product should not be disposed of with regular household waste.
